



Task 1.Design Your Ideal Farm:

Thinking: Imagine you have a piece of land. Design your ideal farm (area), considering the climate, soil type, and the crops you would like to grow.

Creativity Create a blueprint or a model of your farm, labelling different areas and explaining your choices for irrigation, pest control, and harvesting.

Calculate total cost of land, cost involve in cultivation and benefit get from land after harvesting (according to your area).

Learning: Children will develop deep sense of learning towards agriculture.

Example: Assuming an average agricultural land price in a moderately fertile region: ₹5 lakh to ₹20 lakh per acre. Total Land Cost (5 acres): ₹25 lakh to ₹1 Crore

2. Cost Involved in Cultivation (First Year):Land Preparation (plowing, leveling): ₹5,000 - ₹15,000 per acre = ₹25,000 - ₹75,000Seeds & Seedlings: ₹10,000 - ₹20,000 (for diverse crops)Fertilizers & Manure (initial organic inputs): ₹15,000 - ₹30,000



Irrigation System (drip, sprinklers - initial setup): ₹30,000 - ₹80,000

Labor Costs (planting, weeding, general maintenance): ₹500 - ₹1,000 per day (assuming 100 labor days) = ₹50,000 - ₹1,00,000

Pest Control (organic pesticides, materials): ₹5,000 - ₹10,000

Farmhouse & Storage Shed (basic structure - partial cost for the first year): ₹50,000 - ₹1,50,000

Livestock (initial purchase of poultry & goats): ₹20,000 - ₹40,000

Tools & Equipment (basic hand tools, small tiller rental): ₹10,000 - ₹25,000


Miscellaneous Costs (electricity, water pump if needed): ₹5,000 - ₹15,000

Total Cultivation Cost (First Year): ₹2,20,000 - ₹5,55,000 (approximately)
