Practise asking and answering confidently.

4. Picture Story

Paste or draw a picture of any scene and create a short story in 5–6 sentences.

Do this in your spoken English notebook.

You may choose:

- park scene
- playground
- picnic
- family outing
- classroom scene
- market scene

Include:

- who is in the picture
- what they are doing
- what is happening in the scene

Practice narrating your story aloud clearly.

Example: Park Scene Picture Story

“One day, Riya went to the park with her parents. Many children were playing there. Some children were riding bicycles and some were playing on swings. Riya saw a little boy crying near a bench. She helped him find his mother. The boy smiled and thanked Riya.

Everyone was happy.”

5. Conversation Practice

Read and practise the following conversation:

Riya: Hello! How are you?

Aman: I am fine. How are you?

Riya: I am good. What is your favourite food?

Aman: My favourite food is pizza. What about you?

Riya: I like fruits and sandwiches.

Aman: Do you play outdoor games?

Riya: Yes, I play badminton with my friends.

Aman: That sounds fun!

Write it in your Spoken English notebook and practice speaking it. You will be asked to perform it as soon as the school reopens.
